

Patients will usually always have a reason to test. As such it is not 'screening'.

Patient wishes a STI test or has symptoms to merit STI testing

Clinician requests the required tests on ICE as per "MM - Sexual Health, O&G & BBV"

Test results

Chlamydia positive

Requesting practitioner provides treatment as per TAF (doxycycline 100mg BD 7d or click this box for alternatives if contraindications)

Symptomatic penile chlamydia only

No (e.g. vulvovaginal, rectal, throat or asymptomatic penile)

Yes

Patient should advise any sexual partners from 4 weeks before onset of symptoms, to get tested

Patient should advise any sexual partners from 6 months before onset of symptoms, or diagnosis whichever is earlier, to get tested
